CITB provides apprenticeships across a broad range of construction apprenticeships through its subcontracting arrangements offering more specialised construction apprenticeships that may not be on offer in other areas across England. Additionally our approach allows employers to select the best possible apprenticeships that CITB and its subcontracted network has to offer.

CITB underpins its subcontracted provision by providing apprentices and employers with a local apprenticeship officer to support them through the apprenticeship journey to achievement both at college and on site. This approach to apprenticeship provision is proven to increase the success rate of apprentices and this is demonstrable in CITB's success rates being consistently above the national average.
