## Freedom of Information Request: 032021

Your email, dated 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021, referred to Page 15 of the CITB Annual Report and Accounts 2019-20 which noted the allocation of £39.1m to: Flexible funding (£5.5m), Structured funding (£8.1), Skills and training funding (£10.6m), Employer and industry support funding (£5.7m), Construction skills fund (£9m), other funding (£0.2m).

You have asked for the following information:

a. Please provide a split of this £39.1m by reference to large, medium, small, micro and other categories paid in grants and other funding.

We do not hold the information in the format requested.

It would exceed the costs limit provided for in the legislation to locate and collate the data requested.

We are therefore applying the exemption under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) where in order to answer the request, the costs limit set out in section 12 of the Act would be exceeded.

b. Please provide a split of this £39.1m by reference to none levy registered organisations such as trade federations and FE colleges paid in grants and other funding.
