The NOS are the building blocks of N & SVQs, they set out the skills and knowledge a person must have to be deemed competent at their job role and describe best practice. The NOS can also be used to develop training programmes, recruitment profiles, job specifications, career development plans. The development of NOS is a regulatory process, carried out under contract with Skills Development Scotland (SDS) and is overseen by the devolved governments of Wales, Northern Ireland, Scotland and England.
