The response is as follows:

Can you please advise of the pass rate or number of attempts by candidates to successfully pass the MAP - Health, safety and environment test for managers and professionals test, say for the past year.

The pass rate over the last 12 months was 69.9%. This covers the date range of 01/02/23 to 05/02/24.

The MAP test pass rate for the last 3 months is 76% on average which is in line with industry standards and the previous version of the CITB MAP test.
