

# **Recommended Qualification Structure for Temporary Traffic Management (Construction) Level 2**

This structure has been recommended by employers and stakeholders from the above occupational area for organisations to form the basis of academic capability and competence outcomes. Qualifications with a competence outcome at the above level must have units derived from the following National Occupational Standards (NOS) and consist of the mandatory groups as stated for the individual option route.

## **MANDATORY (all option routes)**

- VR379 v2 Maintain temporary traffic management equipment
- VR641 v2 Conform to general workplace health, safety and welfare
- VR642 v1 Conform to productive work practices

## **PLUS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONAL ROUTES**

### **Static Temporary Traffic Management on High Speed Roads Option Route (Total 4)**

#### **Mandatory**

- VR380 v2 Install, maintain and remove static temporary traffic management on motorways and high speed dual carriageways

### **Mobile Temporary Traffic Management on Motorways and Dual Carriageways Option Route (Total 4)**

#### **Mandatory**

- VR381 v2 Implement, monitor and remove mobile traffic management on motorways and dual carriageways

### **Temporary Traffic Management on Urban and Rural Roads Option (Total 4)**

#### **Mandatory**

- VR382 v2 Install, maintain and remove temporary traffic management on urban and rural roads

## **Additional for all options (not compulsory)**

- VR396 v2 Direct and guide the movement of vehicles, plant or machinery
- VR397 v2 Arrange and secure plant or machinery equipment for transportation
- VR400 v2 Operate powered units, tools or pedestrian plant, machinery or equipment
- VR402 v2 Slinging and signalling the movement of suspended loads

## Unit endorsements for Temporary Traffic Management Level 2

Where industry requests; qualifications can be endorsed to show an option route and the type of resources and/or activities that relate to the unit. Listed below are the endorsements that can apply for units derived from the following NOS.

VR400	One of the following: Generators Pumps Pedestrian operated plant or machines Mixers Compressors Self powered tools
VR402	Slinger Signaller 'Occupation specific' only (own area of work: i.e. Temporary traffic management)

**Note:** Where industry requests an Awarding Organisation to further endorse a unit, the Awarding Organisation must first seek approval from the Standards Setting Body to ensure the endorsement is appropriate to the unit.
