## Freedom of Information Request: 042022

Thank you for contacting CITB requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your email, dated 20<sup>th</sup> April 2022, asked for the following information:

This request follows the information published in April 2021 (your reference: 472020). I am looking for up-to-date information to compare against the previous request.

Please provide the following information for the year 21/22.

- 1. Please provide the figures for the total levy paid and grant received by employers counted in each prescribed organisation in 2021. For total levy paid please base this on levy due for the financial year April 2021 to March 2022 compiled from the assessment of 2020 levy returns.
- Please provide the 2021 figures for the total levy paid and grant received by employers who
  stated a federation on their levy return form affiliated to Build UK. Please specify the levy paid
  and grant received for each of the affiliated Build UK federations.
- Please provide the <u>total level</u> of funding awarded to prescribed organisations to 'support the delivery of industry outcomes' in the 2021-22 financial years, along with a breakdown per each prescribed organisation for the same period.
- 4. Please provide details of all direct payments to none levy registered organisations such as trade federations and FE colleges in 2021.
- 5. Please provide a split of levy payment and grant receipts by reference to large, medium, small, micro and other categories for the last financial year.

My response is as follows:

1. Levy Paid by employers who are members of prescribed organisations:

Build UK data includes all member federations, except BWF, FIS, NFDC, HAE, NAS and CPA who are Prescribed Organisations in their own right.

Please note, where an employer is a member of more than one prescribed organisation, their levy is divided equally between the organisations of which it is a member.

Grant received by employers who are members of prescribed organisations:

Build UK data includes all member federations, except BWF, FIS, NFDC HAE, NAS and CPA who are Prescribed Organisations in their own right.



Please note, where an employer is a member of more than one prescribed organisation, their grant is divided equally between the organisations of which it is a member.

See Schedule 1 attached for both the Grant and Levy information requested.

- 2. Levy paid by employers who are members of trade federations who are affiliated with Build UK and Grant received by employers who are members of trade federations who are affiliated with Build UK are provided within Schedule 2.
- 3. The <u>total level</u> of funding awarded to prescribed organisations to 'support the delivery of industry outcomes' in the 2021-22 financial years, along with a breakdown per each prescribed organisation for the same period is provided within Schedule 3 & 3A.
- 4. The details of all direct payments to none levy registered organisations such as trade federations and FE colleges in 2021 are provided within Schedule 4.
- 5. Schedule 5 provides the payments made by all employers to CITB during the last financial year, also the actual grants received by all employers from CITB during the last financial year.

If you are unhappy with this response, or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance.
